Key Details

- Sample collection must be performed by a phlebotomist.
- Talk to your healthcare provider if you are taking blood-thinning medications or have a blood clotting disorder.
- Hydrate for 24-48 hours prior to your blood draw.
- The phlebotomist will collect, prepare, and ship your sample for you.

Before you Start

Collection Preparation

- Check expiration dates on your vials and notify your practitioner if any have expired.
- Find and fill out the barcode sheet from your test kit. Attach a barcode sticker to each collection sample.
 - Ensure clear and legible information, including the scheduled phlebotomy collection date and matching name to the test order.
- Have your complete kit, including the full instruction book, ready for your phlebotomist appointment.
 - Ensure all samples are labeled. Unlabeled samples will be rejected.
